

With reference to the letters on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that the Government of Assam in Medical Education & Research Department hereby issues No Objection Certificate/ Permission to 'Brahmaputra College', Tetelia, Sonapur, Kamrup (M). This NOC is valid for the academic session 2022-2023 and has to be renewed every year thereafter.

This NOC is subject to the following conditions:

1. The NOC does not amount to grant of permission for starting college/course or for admissions which will be granted by the Indian Nursing Council / Assam Nursing Council/ University as prescribed under the respective rules and regulations.
2. The institution shall fulfill all requirements with regard to physical infrastructure, clinical facility and teaching facility as laid in INC guidelines, within one year from the date of issue of this NOC.
3. Periodic reviews will be conducted by Government to verify compliance with all requirements by the institute
- ✓ 4. Any inspection carried out by the Assam Nursing Council after issue of NOC will be jointly undertaken by the officials nominated by DME, Assam and Assam Nursing Council.
5. All copies of the reports of inspection of INC carried out from time to time will be submitted by the Institute to this Department, DME and the affiliating University immediately.
6. The institute will furnish an agreement with the affiliated/ parent hospital for clinical exposure as required under INC guidelines which will clearly state that such an arrangement will not exceed prescribed nurse patient ratio, in order to the avoid overcrowding of hospital and therefore inadequate clinical exposure of students/nurses along with deterioration of patient care.
7. This document will be furnished to Government within a month of issue of NOC by State Government with copies to Indian Nursing Council / Assam Nursing Council/ University.
8. The institution shall obtain approval and affiliation from SSUHS and send copy of the same to Government.
9. The institute shall not admit any student, prior to attaining affiliation of the courses by SSUHS.
10. The institute shall not admit more students, other than the approved capacity by SSUHS.
11. The institutions shall furnish its annual report to the Government as well as University.
12. The Government may impose any other condition(s) at any time, which shall be binding on the institute.
13. Failure to comply with the above conditions will lead to withdrawal of the No Objection Certificate and action deemed fit shall be taken against the institutions.
